A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed with the ML Sondhi Trust to formally launch the Kalinga Sondhi International Forum (KSIF) on 26th April 2025: This strategic collaboration aims to leverage the combined resources and expertise of both institutions to enhance and expand their future initiatives.

May 2025

Formation of the Indo Pacific Forum (IPF):

An immediate outcome of the collaboration mentioned above was the formation of the Indo Pacific Forum (IPF).

The IPF is a compact group of leading experts in the field of foreign policy and strategic affairs drawn from the armed forces, diplomacy and academia. The group holds periodic meetings where in-depth discussions take place on issues of national concern.

24-25 May 2025: Amb Lalit Mansingh, Chairman, Kalinga International Foundation participated in the “International Conference on Kalinga and South East Asia” organized by the Government of Odisha and the Utkal University in Bhubaneswar on 24th and 25th May, 2025. Amb Mansingh was the Chief Guest
